The undersigned, being all the members, managers and officers of FLORIDE OLIVE COUNCIL, L.A.A., a Florida limited agricultural association (the Association") take the following written action in lieu of holding a special meeting regarding same pursuant to the Association's Articles of Association, its Bylaws, and Florida law; and

The undersigned, each being a member of the Association, a member of the Managing Committee of the Association, and an officer of the Association; and, collectively, being all persons who are now or ever were a member, a member of the Managing Committee, or an officer of the Association, and all persons who have or ever had any membership or management rights relating thereto or with respect to the matters set forth below, hereby take the following written action in lieu of holding a special meeting regarding same and consent to the adoption of the following resolution in lieu of a formal or informal meeting of the Association's members or Managing Committee:

RESOLVED, that the form of Amended and Restated Articles of Association of Florida Olive Council, L.A.A. attached hereto are adopted as and for the Amended and Restated Articles of Association of the Association; shall be filed in the official minute book of the Association; and shall be filed in the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida and with the Florida Department of State; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President of the Association is hereby authorized and directed to do all such things and take all other actions that he, in his sole and absolute discretion, deems necessary, appropriate, or desirable to carry out or effectuate the forgoing resolution.

The undersigned waive all formal requirements, including the necessity of holding a formal or informal meeting and any requirement that notice of such meeting be given.

# AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION of FLORIDA OLIVE COUNCIL, L.A.A.

The name of the association is Florida Olive Council, L.A.A. The Articles of Association of the association were filed with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations on July 27, 2011 (document no. X11000000001) and are hereby amended and restated in their entirety to read as follows:

We, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States, have voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a limited agricultural association under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida, and particularly under the provisions of Chapter 604, sec. 604.09, et seq., Fla. Stat., and certify to the following:

#### Article I. Name

The name of the association shall be FLORIDA OLIVE COUNCIL, L.A.A.

## Article II. Principal Place of Business

The principal place of business of the association within the State of Florida is located at 2248 N.W. 6th Place, Gainesville, FL 32603. The mailing address of the association is 3324 W. University Ave., #160, Gainesville, FL 32607.

#### Article III. Purpose

The association is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to other organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, but only to the limited extent that the association's activities promote, foster, and encourage more efficient and progressive production, marketing, or selling of olives and related agricultural products within the state of Florida, and the association in general functions as a limited agricultural association within the meaning of section 604.09, Fla. Stat.

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#### Article IV. Duration

The term of existence is perpetual.

# Article V. Conduct of the Association's Business

The business of the association shall be conducted by a president, one or more vice presidents, and a secretary-treasurer, all of whom shall be elected by and serve at the pleasure of the association's Managing Committee. All officers shall be members of the association. The following officers shall conduct the business of the association until their successors shall have qualified:

Barbara R. Klein

Secretary-Treasurer:

No part of the net earnings of the association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, managers, officers, trustees or other private persons, except that the association shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the association shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the association shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### Article VI. Members

The original members of the association are Michael O'Hara Garcia, Barbara R. Klein, and Stephen A. Scott, all of whom have continuously been and now remain the only members of the association, all in good standing.



Additional members of the association shall be admitted on such terms as may be prescribed in the association's bylaws.

#### Article VII. Managing Committee

The activities and affairs of the association shall be managed by a Managing Committee, the members of which shall be members of the association. The association's initial Managing Committee shall be comprised of three members. The initial members of the Managing Committee are Michael O'Hara Garcia, Barbara R. Klein and Stephen A. Scott, all of whom have continuously been and now remain the sole members of the Managing Committee. The number of Managing Committee members may be fixed from time to time by the vote of the entire Managing Committee as provided in the association's bylaws, but shall never be fewer than three.

### Article VIII. No Personal Liability

No member of the association shall be held personally liable for any of the claims against or the indebtedness and obligations of the association.

# Article VIII. Disposition of Assets Upon Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the association, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the association is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

The foregoing amendment was approved by the unanimous consent of the members of the association and by the unanimous consent of the members of the association's Managing Committee, which vote was sufficient for approval thereof, and these Amended and Restated Articles of Association were subscribed by the undersigned, this 2 day of February, 2014.
